Rosemary Dustman

Director Pupil Personnel Services, Coordinator of Guidance, Counselor, Teacher 1951-1985

Miss Dustman began her career with District 87 as a teacher at Washington Junior High School in 1951. She was a teacher and a counselor at Bent Junior High School from 1952 until 1961, when she was named Coordinator of Guidance – a position she held until 1968. Miss Dustman was named Director of Pupil Personnel Services in 1968 and worked in that capacity until her retirement in 1985.

During her tenure with the district, Miss Dustman coordinated the District's testing program, guidance counseling, home bound teaching, bilingual education, indigent services, speech & language and nursing services. She initiated the counseling program within the District's elementary schools. She developed and conducted studies of graduates and dropouts and published reports and recommendations regarding both. She revised the District's student record system.

Miss Dustman assisted in developing the Bloomington High School Career Guidance Center. The Rosemary Dustman Scholarship for BHS graduates is named for her.
